A local law ALLOWING BINGO IN THE TOWN OF COVERT

## Section 1.

Pursuant to and subject to the provisions of Article 14-H of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and the provisions of the Bingo Control Law of said state, it shall be lawful for any authorized organizations, upon obtaining a license therefor as provided for in said Article 14-H, to conduct the game of bingo within the territorial limits of the Town of Covert, Seneca County, New York.

## Section 2.

This Local Law shall be submitted for approval to the electors of the Town of Covert, at the next general town election to be held on November 2, 2004.

## Section 3.

Any other local law, ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

## Section 4.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
