Pursuant to and subject to the provisions of Article 14-H of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and the provisions of the Bingo Control Law of said state, it shall be lawful for any authorized organizations, upon obtaining a license therefor as provided for in said Article 14-H, to conduct the game of bingo within the territorial limits of the Town of Covert, Seneca County, New York.
